

I have considered all the responses in relation to this issue and I have the following to add:

As CH colleagues and INSS colleagues rightly point out, there is no vires in the LP Act 1907 which requires the Registrar to register and or publish Insolvency information on LPs. However we have in the past simply appended the winding up information to the register for information, attached to the statutory LP6 form.

The enquirer is correct that there is essentially a gap in legislation which prevents easy access to insolvency information on LP's, and in this regard we should, in the interests of making the information publically available, register the LP6 and WUO for information only.

What we cannot do is to capture the name of the Official Receiver, or change the status of the LP on our system in any way (eg L or R flag on names index etc), there is nothing in the legislation that allows us to do this in the same way as we do for other limited company types.

However the Registrar does recognise the public importance of this information and as a compromise is prepared to publish it for information. We have discussed this issue with operational colleagues and our processes have been amended to reflect this policy.

Hope this helps, happy to provide more if required.
