REPORT OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The Management Committee presents their report and financial statements for the year ended 5 June 2007.

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

2006-07 has been a year of excellent progress for Echo Echo Dance Theatre Company and it has continued to build on it's recent development by expanding it's profile and reputation as one of the country's leading contemporary dance organisations. It has continued to produce and tour original and innovative new work and, in doing so, increase participation in dance and audiences for dance throughout Ireland.

During the year, Echo Echo established it's new dance studio and administrative base at the Waterside Theatre, allowing the company complete programming control over it's accessible studio space for the first time.

The company expanded it's performance, education and outreach partnership programmes to meet increased demand for high quality contemporary dance training and education throughout the North West region and beyond.

RESULTS AND REVIEW OF BUSINESS

The Company is a non-profit making organisation. The result are set out in detail on pages 4 to 9. Overall the Company had a surplus of £11,626. There was a surplus in restricted funds for the year of £20,758 and the total restricted balances carried forward at 5 June 2007 were £43,672. However there was a deficit in unrestricted funds for the year of £9,132, and this was covered by unrestricted balances brought forward from the previous year, leaving unrestricted balances carried forward at 5 June 2007 of £1,585.

FUTURE STRATEGY

The Company has a Strategic Plan in place for the years 2007 to 2010 and it will continue it's activities in accordance with this Plan in the forthcoming years subject to satisfactory funding arrangements.

RISK MANAGEMENT

The committee have assessed the major risks to which the Company is exposed, in particular those related to the operations and finances of the Company, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate the exposure to major risks.

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE'S RESPONSIBILITY STATEMENT

The Management Committee are required to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Company at the end of the financial year and of the surplus or deficit for that year. In preparing the financial statements appropriate accounting policies have been used and applied consistently, and reasonable and prudent judgements and estimates have been made. The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards.

The Management Committee are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Company and to enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies (Norhtern Ireland) Order 1986. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

AUDITORS

A resolution proposing that E F McCambridge & Co. be re-appointed as Auditors of the Group will be put to the Annual General Meeting.

BASIS OF OPINION

We conducted our audit in accordance with Auditing Standards issued by the Auditing Practices Board. An audit includes examination, on a test basis, of evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. It also includes an assessment of the judgements made by the management committee in the preparation of the financial statements, and of whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Company's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

NOTES ON AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 5 JUNE 2007

1 PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Income

(i) Grants

Grants represent all amounts received and receivable during the year.

Grants that relate to specific capital expenditure are treated as deferred income which is credited to the Statement of Financial Activities on a straight line basis over four years. Revenue Grants are credited to the Statement of Financial Activities in the year they are received.

(ii) Sundry Income

This comprises amounts received during the year.

(b) Expenditure

(i) Direct charitable expenditure

This represents all expenditure directly attributable to charitable causes.

(ii) Management and administration

This includes all other expenditure not directly allocated above and a proportion of the overhead costs attributable to management and administration.

(c) Taxation

As a charity, Echo Echo Dance Theatre Company is not liable to either Income Tax or Corporation Tax.

(d) Fund accounting

The Company has various types of funds for which it is responsible and which require separate disclosure. These are as follows:

(i) Restricted funds

Donations received which are earmarked by the donor for specific purposes. Such purposes are within the overall aims of the organisation.

(ii) Unrestricted funds

Funds which are expendable at the discretion of the Company in furtherance of the objectives of the charity. In addition funds may be held in order to finance capital investment and working capital.
