- I, Matthew Higgins, Solicitor of 296 Cliftonville Road, Belfast, make Oath and say as follows:-
- 1. I am a partner in the firm of Higgins Hollywood Deazley, the Solicitors on record for the Applicant and am duly authorised to make this Affidavit on his behalf and in support of the Application herein to restore A&L Security Management Limited to the Register of Companies for Northern Ireland.
- 2. I beg to refer to the following pleadings when produced pinned together and marked 'MFH1' at the time of swearing hereof:-
 - (i) Writ of Summons issued on the 19 January 2005;
 - (ii) Statement of Claim served the 16 February 2005;
 - (iii) Order of Master Wilson dated 22 June 2006 pursuant to which the Applicant was given liberty to amend the Writ of Summons to identify the First Named Defendant by its proper corporate identity, that is A&L Security Management Ltd;
 - (iv) Order of Master McCorry dated 12 February 2007 extending time for the Applicant to comply with the aforesaid Order of Master Wilson;
 - Order marking default judgement against the First Named Defendant dated 22 December 2006;
 - (vi) Order Setting Aside Default Judgement dated 13 March 2007.
- 3. As appears, the Applicant claims damages for personal injuries, loss and damage sustained by him on the 2 February 2003, while a lawful visitor to a night club owned by the Second Named Defendant. It is alleged that on the night in question, the Applicant was subjected to a vicious assault by servants

and agents of the First Named Defendant, the security company, as a result of which the Applicant sustained serious personal injuries, loss and damge.

- 4. Security Management Ltd was incorporated under the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 on 2 July 2002 and I beg leave to refer to copies of the Certificate of Incorporation and Memorandum and Articles of Association of the said company pinned together by me at the time of swearing hereof and marked 'MFH2'.
- 5. The aforesaid company was, I believe, dissolved on 24 November 2006 for failing to file documents.
- 6. I am advised by Counsel and believe that there is a strong prima facie case against the company in question and that in order to pursue the Applicant's personal injuries claim it is essential that an Application be made to restore the company to the Register.
- 7. The Originating Summons herein has been served upon both the Registrar and the Crown. Correspondence from the latter is now shown to me and marked'MFH3'.
- 8. The company insurers have indicated that they are not indemnifying the Security Company but the Applicant ultimately will be relying on his rights under the Third Parties Rights Against Insurers Act 1930.
- 9. By reason of the foregoing, I humbly ask this Honourable Court to grant the relief claimed herein.
- 10. Save as where otherwise appears, I depose to the foregoing from facts within my own knowledge and belief.

The Company was dissolved and was removed from the Register on 24/11/06


I have no objection to the Restoration of the company provided that an undertaking is given: -
