### NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2008

#### 1. Accounting policies

#### a) Basis of accounting

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable accounting standards and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice 'Accounting by Limited Liability Partnerships.'

#### b) Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods and services excluding VAT.

#### c) Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write down the cost of all tangible fixed assets over their expected useful economic lives at the following rates:

Motor vehicles : 25% reducing balance Fixtures, tools & equipment : 25% reducing balance Computer equiment : 33.33% straight line

#### d) Members' remuneration

Profit shares are determined annually in advance in accordance with agreed profit sharing arrangements. Profits are automatically divided between the members and hence there are no unallocated profits. Allocated profits are included within 'loans and other debts due to members' and rank pari passu with ordinary creditors in the event of a winding up.
