1 Accounting policies

Limited liability partnership information

Nova House LLP is a limited liability partnership incorporated in England and Wales. The registered office is Colenso House, Omega 1, Monks Cross Drive, York, YO32 9GZ.

The limited liability partnership's principal activities are disclosed in the Members' Report.

1.1 Accounting convention

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice "Accounting by Limited Liability Partnerships" issued in January 2017, together with FRS 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" ("FRS 102") and the requirements of the Companies Act 2006 as applicable to companies subject to the small companies regime.
