1. orders that Johnston Press PLC, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts (Registered Number SC015382) be restored to the Register of Companies in terms of section 1031 of the Companies Act 2006, such restoration to take effect on a copy of this order being delivered to the Registrar;
2. directs the Registrar of Companies to publish in *The Edinburgh Gazette* notice of the restoration of the Company to the register;
3. orders that the company be wound up by the Court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986 ("the 1986 Act");
4. in terms of section 140(1) of the 1986 Act, nominates and appoints Alastair Paul Beveridge of AlixPartners UK LLP, 6 New Street Square, London and Catherine Williamson of AlixPartners UK LLP, 8th Floor Ship Canal House, 98 King Street, Manchester, to be joint

interim liquidators of the Company, both insolvency practitioners, both duly qualified under the said Act, to be joint liquidators of said company;

5. declares in terms of Section 231 of the Insolvency Act 1986 that any act required or authorised by any enactment be done by either of the joint liquidators;
6. appoints the clerk of court to send a copy of this order forthwith to each of the said joint liquidators;
7. appoints to each of the said joint liquidators to give notice of their appointment in terms of Rule 5.26 of the Insolvency (Scotland) (Receivership and Winding up) Rules 2018;
8. authorises the expenses of this petition and the procedure following thereon, including any expenses to be paid to the Registrar in connection with the proceedings for the restoration of the Company to the register, to be paid out of the first and readiest funds of the Company;
9. and decerns.
