### NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2015

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### **Accounting convention**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain assets and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

#### Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods and services, as modified by FRS5 Application Note G and UITF Abstract 40.

#### Goodwill

Goodwill in connection with the acquisition of a business during the year ended 31 May 2007, has been fully amortised.

#### Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Land and buildings

- 2% on cost

Plant and machinery etc

- 33% on cost, 25% on reducing balance and 10% on reducing balance

#### Investment property

Investment property is shown at most recent valuation. Any aggregate surplus or deficit arising from changes in market value is transferred to a revaluation reserve.

No provision is made for depreciation of investment properties. Although this accounting policy is in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), it is a departure from the general requirements of the Companies Act 2006 for all tangible fixed assets to be depreciated. In the opinion of the director, compliance with the standard is necessary for the financial statements to give a true and fair view. Depreciation is only one of the many factors reflected in the annual valuation and the amount of this that might otherwise have been charged cannot be separately identified or quantified.

#### Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

#### Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date. Deferred tax is measured at the average rates that would apply when the timing differences are expected to reverse.

#### Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company contributes to personal pension policies on behalf of some employees. Contributions for the year are charged to the profit and loss account.

#### **Current asset investments**

Current asset investments are stated at cost less provisions for permanent diminution in value.
