Report of the Directors for the Year Ended 31 March 2008

The directors have pleasure in presenting their report with the financial statements of the company for the year ended 31 March 2008.

The year was spent reviewing the ongoing options for Kaleidoscope in light of the fact that we were unsuccessful in obtaining funds from either the Scottish Arts Council or Aberdeenshire Council. Following a meeting in July 2007 it was agreed not to undertake any activities in the year and to consider what kind of future the Festival could have in light of the ongoing funding situation. It may be that once there is clarity over the future direction of Creative Scotland, previously the Scottish Arts Council, we may seek support. The funds received from Aberdeen City Council will be held in the account to be used for supporting theatrical work taking place in the City for primary school children.

TRUSTEES

The present trustees who are also directors of the company are listed on page 1. No salaries or expenses were paid to any director in the year.

GOVERNING DOCUMENT

The company is governed by its articles and memorandum of association drawn up in accordance with the Companies Act.

OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the company is to promote and hold, in and around Aberdeen, regular international Childrens' festivals of performing companies and artists participating for the benefit of children in Scotland and through the world. In doing so, to advance the education and enjoyment of children and thus enable them to have a closer understanding of their environment and each other.

INVESTMENT POLICIES

As surplus funds are expected to be used in the near future, the company does not invest in investments for financial return but maintains its funds on bank current account. The directors are of the opinion that all the companys funds are unrestricted within the purposes of the organisation.
