

## NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 OCTOBER 2005

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### Going concern

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis which assumes that the company will continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. The company incurred a loss before taxation of £10,436 during the year ended At 31 October 2005 and at that date its current liabilities exceeded its current assets by £23.634. The company is thus dependent on the continuing financial support of its directors and other creditors. The directors are confident of this continuing support and of the company's long term trading prospects and on this basis consider it appropriate to prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis. The financial statements do not include any adjustments which would result from the withdrawal of financial support.

#### Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

### Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Fixtures and equipment

- 25% on cost

#### Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

### Film development and production

Film and television development and production are written off to the profit and loss account in the year in which the related income is earned. Where there is a reasonable certainty of future material income, then the expenditure is deferred and amortised over the period during which the company is expected to benefit.

#### Grants receivable

Grants received in respect of expenditure charged to the profit and loss account during the year have been included in profit and loss.
