

REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS

The directors submit their annual report and financial statements for Vodafone (Scotland) Limited (the 'Company') for the financial year ended 31 March 2023.

Principal activity and future developments

The Company acts as an intermediate holding company. The Company was dormant within the meaning of Section 1169 of the Companies Act 2006 throughout the financial year and accordingly no profit and loss account has been presented. The directors do not expect the Company to trade in the foreseeable future.

For the year ended 31 March 2023 and the prior year, the Company did not trade.

Indemnification of directors

In respect of those matters for which the directors may not be indemnified, Vodafone Group Plc maintained a directors' and officers' liability insurance policy throughout the financial period, and up to the date of approval of the financial statements. This policy is renewed annually in August. Neither the Company's indemnity nor the insurance provides cover in the event that the director is proven to have acted dishonestly or fraudulently.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2023

1. Statement of accounting policies

The accounting policies adopted in respect of material items are described below. The accounting policies have been applied on a consistent basis during the current and the preceding year.

Basis of preparation

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards, including Financial Reporting Standard 102 — 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland' ('FRS 102'), and with the Companies Act 2006.

The financial statements are presented in Sterling (£).

The exemptions available under FRS 102 have been applied to the following items:

- Financial instrument disclosures, including:
 - categories of financial instruments,
 - items of income, expenses, gains or losses relating to financial instruments; and
 - exposure to and management of financial risks.
- Related Party Disclosures

As a wholly owned indirect subsidiary of a company registered in England and Wales, for which consolidated financial statements are prepared, the Company has taken advantage of Section 400 of the Companies Act 2006 and has not prepared consolidated financial statements.

Going concern

The Company continues to adopt the going concern basis in preparing its financial statements.

Critical accounting estimates and judgements

Estimates and judgements are continually evaluated and are based on historical experience and other factors, including expectations of future events that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances.

The financial statements do not contain any significant estimates or judgements that would reasonably impact the results and balances presented.

Investments

Investments held as fixed assets are stated at cost less provision for impairment in value

Debtors

Receivables are measured at transaction price, less any impairment. Receivables are written off when management considers them to be irrecoverable.

If collection is expected in one year or less, they are classified as current assets. If not, they are classified as non-current assets.

1. Statement of accounting policies (continued)

Creditors

Creditors are obligations to pay for goods and services that have been acquired in the ordinary course of business from suppliers.

Creditors are recognised initially at fair value and subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest rate method.
