1. Introduction

Kenneth Robert Craig of RSM Tenon Recovery, 48 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5TS was appointed as Provisional Liquidator of 55 Degrees Limited by the Sheriff of Glasgow & Strathkelvin at Glasgow Sheriff Court on 13 June 2011 following presentation of a petition by its Directors on 10 June 2011.

Kenneth Robert Craig of RSM Tenon Recovery, 48 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5TS was appointed as Interim Liquidator of 55 Degrees Limited by the Sheriff of Glasgow & Strathkelvin at Glasgow Sheriff Court on 14 July 2011.

Kenneth Robert Craig was appointed as Liquidator of 55 Degrees Limited by the Sheriff Glasgow & Strathkelvin at Glasgow Sheriff Court on 6 September 2011.

Kenneth Robert Craig is the Liquidator of the Company and this is his report to the creditors of the Company showing how the liquidation has been conducted for the whole period of the liquidation.

2. Statutory Information

Statutory information relating to the Company is attached at Appendix I.

3. Liquidator's Receipts and Payments Account

A summary of the Liquidator's receipts and payments account for the relevant period from 10 December 2012 to 28 June 2013 (the date of this report) and cumulatively from commencement of liquidation on 10 June 2011 to 28 June 2013 is attached at **Appendix II**.

4. Action taken by the Liquidator

Trade debts

The collection of trade debts was brought to a close. An amount of £7,098.60 was ingathered over the course of the Liquidation.

5. Liabilities and Dividends

Secured creditors

There were no secured creditors.

Preferential creditors

Claims totalling £61,764.05 were received from 24 preferential creditors.

No dividend was paid to preferential creditors because there were insufficient realisations to meet the Liquidator's fees and other administrative costs of the liquidation in full.

Floating charge creditors

The Bank of Scotland plc holds a bond and floating charge over the company assets created 3 May 2000 and registered 8 May 2000. The floating charge creditor has indicated that it is due £32,058.03.

No dividend was paid to the floating charge creditor because there were insufficient realisations to meet the Liquidator's fees and other administrative costs of the liquidation in full.

Prescribed Part

As there was no distribution to the floating charge creditor the prescribed part provisions do not apply.

Ordinary creditors

Claims totalling £608,152.01 were received from 61 creditors.

No dividend has been paid to ordinary creditors because there were insufficient realisations to meet the Liquidator's fees and other administrative costs of the estate.

6. Liquidator's Remuneration, Disbursements and Expenses

Basis of remuneration and disbursements

At the statutory meeting of creditors, creditors agreed that the Liquidator would be remunerated by reference to the time properly spent in dealing with matters in the liquidation and that any disbursements would be drawn in accordance with the tariff outlined in **Appendix III**.

1. Explanation of Liquidator's charging and disbursement recovery policies

1.1. Time recording

Work undertaken on cases is recorded in six minute units in an electronic time recording system. Time properly incurred on cases is charged at the hourly rate of the grade of staff undertaking the work that applies at the time the work is done. The current hourly charge-out rates are:

1.2. Disbursement recovery

Disbursements are categorised as either Category 1 or Category 2.

Category 1 disbursements:

External supplies of incidental services specifically identifiable to the case. Where these have initially been paid by RSM Tenon Restructuring and then recharged to the estate, approval from creditors is not required.

Examples of category 1 disbursements include postage, case advertising, specific bond insurance, company search fees, external room hire, storage, case management software system, invoiced travel and properly reimbursed expenses incurred by personnel in connection with the case (including business mileage up to HMRC approved rate for cases commenced before 1 November 2011).

Category 2 disbursements:

These include elements of shared or allocated costs incurred by RSM Tenon Restructuring and recharged to the estate; they are not attributed to the estate by a third party invoice and/or they may include a profit element. These disbursements are recoverable in full, subject to the basis of the disbursement charge being approved by creditors in advance.
