The board of Directors has considered the most appropriate policy for investing funds and has found that short to medium term investment of funds should be held in a mixture of current and term bank accounts to optimise interest earned.

1. Accounting Policies

The following accounting policies have been used consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the charity's financial statements.

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and follow recommendations in Statement of Recommended Practice; Accounting by Charities.

Fixed assets

Fixed assets are recorded at cost or, in cases where fixed assets have been donated to DawatulIslam Glasgow Limited, at valuation at the time of acquisition.

Depreciation

Depreciation has been provided at the following rates in order to write down the cost or valuation, less estimated residual value, of all tangible fixed assets over their expected useful lives as follows:-

Freehold Properties Fixtures and fittings

2% p.a. straight line 15% p.a. reducing balance

Fees, contributions and grants

These comprise amounts receivable during the year.

Investment income

Investment income is recognised in the accounts when it is received.

Value added tax

As the majority of Dawatul Islam Glasgow Limited's activities are classified as exempt or non – business activities for the purposes of value added tax, Dawatul Glasgow Limited is unable to reclaim all the value added tax which it suffers on its purchases. Expenditure in these financial statement is therefore shown inclusive of value added tax.

Taxation

No provision has been made for corporation tax or deferred tax as the charity is a registered charity and is therefore exempt.
