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REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 31⁵¹ MARCH 2007

The trustees, who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act, present their annual report and financial statements for the period ended 31st March 2007. The Directors have adopted the provisions of the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" issued in October 2000 in preparing their annual report and financial statements of the charity.

Objects of the charity, principal activities and organisation of our work

The charity is constituted as a company limited by guarantee, and is therefore governed by a memorandum and articles of association

The charity's object and its principal activity continues to be that of the provision of assistance to the disabled to find suitable housing in Fife

The charity is organised so that the Directors meet regularly to manage its affairs

Development, activities and achievements during the period

The directors consider that the development of the charity has been satisfactory

The charity would not be able to function without continued voluntary input from the directors and other workers

Transactions and financial position

The statement of financial activities shows net expenditure of £6,792 for the period and our reserves stand at £33,775 in total

This level of reserves is required to meet future operating commitments

Directors and Trustees

All directors of the company are also trustees of the charity, there are no other trustees. Two directors resigned at the AGM and were re appointed. The board has the power to appoint additional directors as it considers fit to do so.

Risk Management

The directors actively review the major risks which the charity faces on a regular basis and believe that maintaining reserves at current levels, combined with regular reviews of controls over key financial systems, will provide sufficient resources in the event of adverse conditions. The directors have also examined other operational and business risks faced by the charity and confirm that they have established systems to mitigate the significant risks.

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2000) issued in October 2000, SORP Update Bulletin 1 issued in December 2002, applicable accounting standards and the Companies Act 1985

1 2 Fixed Assets and depreciation

Depreciation is provided to write off the cost of the tangible fixed asset over its estimated useful economic life as follows

Computer equipment

33% straight line basis

Fixtures & fittings

15% reducing balance basis

13 Incoming resources

Income represents monies receivable in relation to expenses for the period

1.4 Resources expended

Resources expended are included in the Statement of Financial Activities on the accruals basis, inclusive of any VAT which cannot be recovered

Charitable expenditure is divided into that spending which is directly incurred in the provision of assistance to the disabled to find suitable housing, and that which is incurred indirectly to manage and administer the provision of the service

1.5 Pension costs

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions are charged to the profit and loss account for the period in which they are payable to the scheme.
