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Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 31 January 2022

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

Our purpose, as recorded in our Memorandum and Articles of Association, is to advance public education by the encouragement of the performing arts including, without limiting the foregoing, the arts of drama, ballet, dance, mime, music and opera.

Significant activities

The company was dormant this year. The artistic director has had to take on family caring duties as in the present climate, it is extremely difficult to find care staff.

However, various development opportunities continue to be undertaken. These include performances of a new play "Still" at the Traverse theatre. It is hoped to continue with a collaboration next year.

During the Edinburgh Festival, there was a collaboration with Annie George on her autobiographical piece "Home Is Not The Place". Other projects are planned for the next two years.

The artistic director participated in a development of a new version of "Jekyll and Hyde" with the Citizen's Theatre in Glasgow.

Various writing projects are still ongoing

Public benefit

The charity continues to plan to undertake projects within the performing arts to further the public benefit.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
