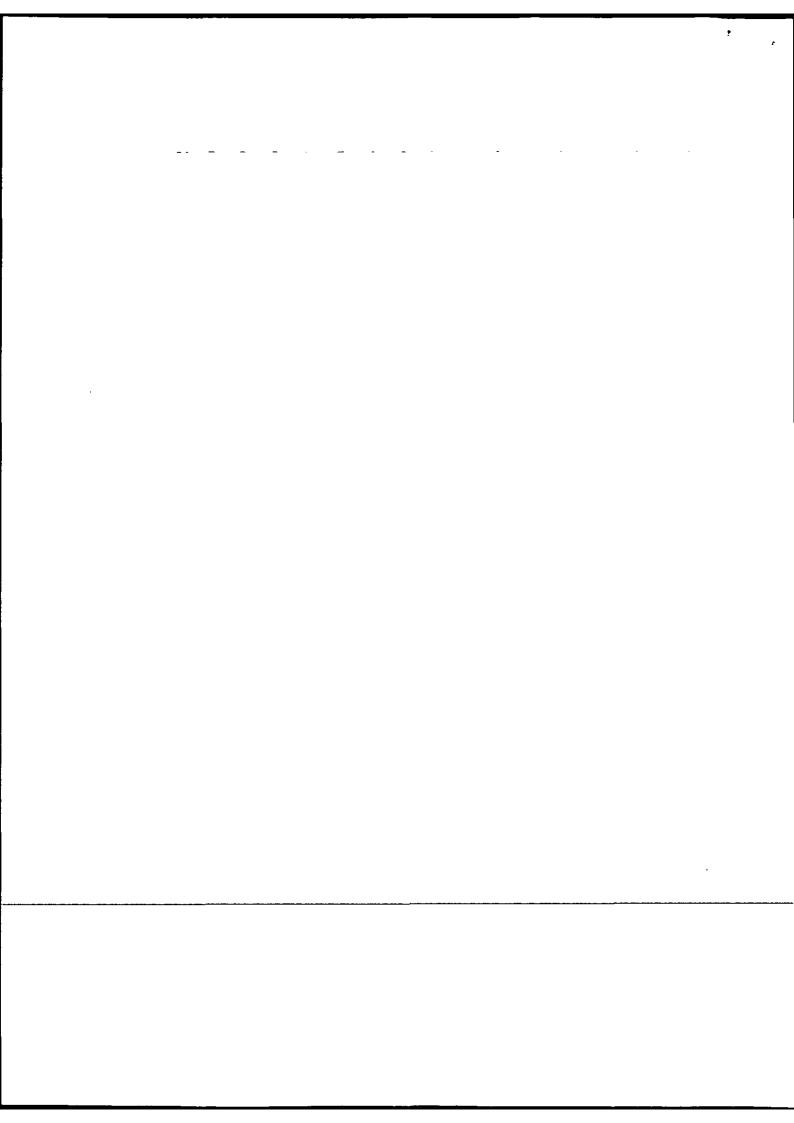

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

The organisation is a charitable company limited by guarantee, incorporated on 7th March 2002. The company was constituted under a Memorandum of Association which established its objects and powers and is regulated by its Articles of Association. In the event of the company being wound up the members would be required to contribute an amount not exceeding £1.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2011

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The directors of the company are also charity trustees for the purposes of charity law. Under the requirements of the Articles of Association any person or corporate body or institution who desires to be admitted to the membership of the company must sign and deliver to the company an application for admission. This application will be considered by the council at the appropriate meeting. A member shall cease to be so either by written notice lodged at the office or if he/she is removed from membership by a resolution of the council passed by a majority of three-fourths of the votes cast upon such resolution at a meeting specially convened to consider such resolution.

Risk management

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The company's primary objects and principal activities are those of relieving the poverty and distress, increasing the health and welfare, and advancing the education of young people with caring responsibilities in East Lothian.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

In 2010-2011 East Lothian Young Carers worked hard to reach and support young carers throughout East Lothian. Our young carers clubs continued to be a very popular resource with young carers, their families and referring agencies. During the year we supported over 60 young carers and their families through our young carers clubs and family support service. The clubs provide young carers with respite, fun, the time and space to develop friendships with other young carers and the opportunity to discuss with staff any problems they may be having. Young carers often attend the clubs for a number of years.

The high number of young carers requiring support together with our HIF funding ending in March 2011 meant that securing additional funding for the organisation was a priority during the year and a significant achievement for the year was the securing of additional funding from East Lothian Council. We also were successful in a bid to the Short Breaks Fund. This funding will allow us to support additional young carers and their families in 2011-2012.

It is important to ELYC that we work closely with our partners in Health and Social Work to ensure young carers are identified and offered support as early as possible. During the year we supported a local social work team to run a young carers group for children caring for a sibling. The group was held at ELYC's office and benefited from being able to access ELYC's resources and support from ELYC staff.

During the year ELYC continued to press for young carers to be recognised in policy and planning within East Lothian. Through petitioning by ELYC and support from local Councillors Young Carers issues are now being recognised in East Lothian Councils carers planning.

In 2011-2012 ELYC hopes to extend our respite service to young carers and ensure our service provision reflects the needs of young carers and their families. We will also continue to campaign for young carers issues to be fully integrated into planning in Childrens Services, Community Care Services and Health Services in East Lothian.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

During the year the charity recorded a net increase in funds of £40,109.

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF EAST LOTHIAN YOUNG CARERS

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2011

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Companies Act 2006 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Fixtures and fittings

- 10% on cost

Computer equipment

- 33% on cost

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the statement of financial activities on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.
