

COMPANY LIQUIDATION**WINDING UP ORDER****Stirling****07 August 2012**

The sheriff having resumed consideration of the foregoing petition together with the productions produced, and having seen the Edinburgh Gazette dated 27 July 2012 and the Scotsman newspaper dated 25 July 2012 each containing the intimation ordered by the preceding interlocutor, no answers to said petition having been lodged in court, Finds

(1) that the amount of the share capital of the said James Hay Heat (Scotland) Ltd. paid up or credited as paid up does not exceed £120,000

(2) that the said company is unable to pay its debts

therefore Orders that the said company having its registered office at Silvercraigs, 144 Bannockburn Road, Stirling FK7 0EW be wound up in pursuance of the Insolvency Act, 1986; Nominates and Appoints Penny McCoull, Glenhead House, Port of Menteith, Stirlingshire FK8 3LE to be the interim liquidator of the said company with the usual powers, all in terms of said Statute and of Law; Finds the petitioner entitled to the expenses of this application as taxed by the auditor of court.
