# NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2012

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### 1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

At the balance sheet date, the company had net current liabilities of £14,663 (2011 - £57,971). The directors have prepared the financial statements on the going concern basis which is dependent upon the support of the directors. The financial statements do not include any adjustment that would results should the support from the directors be withdrawn.

#### 1.2 Turnover

Turnover comprises the invoiced value of sound production, staging and lighting services supplied, exclusive of Value Added Tax.

#### 1.3 Intangible fixed assets and amortisation

Goodwill is the difference between amounts paid on the acquisition of a business and the fair value of the identifiable assets and liabilities. It is amortised to the profit and loss account over its estimated economic life.

#### 1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Property improvements
Plant & machinery

Motor vehicles

5% straight line

16.67% straight line
25% reducing balance

### 1.5 Deferred taxation

Full provision is made for deferred tax assets and liabilities arising from all timing differences between the recognition of gains and losses in the financial statements and recognition in the tax computation.

A net deferred tax asset is recognised only if it can be regarded as more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are calculated at the tax rates expected to be effective at the time the timing differences are expected to reverse.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

### 1.6 Grants

Grants relating to tangible fixed assets are treated as deferred income and released to the profit and loss account over the expected useful lives of the assets concerned. Other grants are credited to the profit and loss account as the related expenditure is incurred.

#### 5. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

Included within other creditors is an amount of £36,136 (2011 - £48,488) due to the directors. The maximum amount outstanding during the year was £48,488.

The company paid rent of £12,500 (2011 - £12,500) to the trustees of a SIPP, of which Alan Martin is the sole member.

During the year, dividends of £6,600 (2011 - £10,000) were paid to the directors.
