on 19 January 2011 at 10am**

1 I was appointed to act as Liquidator at the meeting of creditors held on 23 April 2010.

2 The Abstract of Receipts and Payments which accompanies the Notice calling this meeting covered the period from the commencement of the Liquidation on 18 February 2010 to 9 December 2010. This indicated that there were insufficient funds in the Liquidation to pay a dividend to any class of creditors.

Realisations

3 The Statement of Affairs presented at the statutory meeting of creditors advised that it was unlikely any funds would be realised in the liquidation. During the course of the Liquidation investigations were conducted regarding the assets of the company as well as book debts, however no recoveries were made.

Administration Expenses

4 Expenses of the Liquidation including legal costs, bordereau, advertisements, public notices, storage, stationery and postage, totalled £914.68.

Liquidator's Fee

5 Liquidator's fees carried out in connection with the Liquidation were met by a third party.
