INTRODUCTION

Labelgraphics (Scotland) Limited (Entity) entered members' voluntary liquidation on 30 April 2018. Emma Cray and Toby Underwood were appointed joint liquidators of the Entity (Liquidators).

This account covers the conduct and progress of the liquidation in the period from 30 April 2018 to 20 May 2020 (Period). This is the Liquidators' final account of the liquidation and should be read in conjunction with the Liquidators' previous annual meeting reports.

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets:

Following their appointment, the Liquidators took control of the assets listed in the directors' Declaration of Solvency.

The Liquidators have not identified any additional assets of the Entity and are not aware of any other assets that remain to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency showed that the Entity had no liabilities.

In the Period, the Liquidators published a notice in the Edinburgh Gazette inviting creditors to submit details of claims they may have against the Entity.

The Liquidators have not received any claims in the liquidation.

HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"):

Following their appointment, the Liquidators wrote to HMRC to inform them of the liquidation and to request details of any outstanding liabilities. HMRC have confirmed that the Entity has no outstanding tax liabilities and that they have no objection to the liquidation being closed.

Distributions to Members:

On 20 April 2020 an in specie distribution of £308 (representing £1 per share) was made to the Member of the Entity. The distribution consisted of an inter-group debt of £308 due from the Member, together with any other assets held by the Company

The value attributed to the distribution was based on the value at which the asset was held in the Entity's books.
