1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

The company had net liabilities of £2,641,850 at 31 December 2012. The company is dependent on the continued support of the company's bankers who are working with the directors and shareholders whilst the completed properties in the company's Aberdeen development are marketed for sale. The continuing support of the bankers is not certain. The remaining costs of marketing and selling the properties will be recognised and paid as properties are sold.

The directors continue to believe the going concern basis of accounting is appropriate due to the continuing support of the company's bankers whilst the completed properties are marketed and negotiations continue with the contractors and the professional teams involved in the development.

1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).

1.3 Turnover

Turnover represents sales of private flats on receipt of the cash price and amounts receiveable in respect of rental income. Turnover excludes value added tax.

1.4 Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

1.5 Deferred taxation

Deferred taxation is provided in full in respect of taxation deferred by timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. The deferred tax balance has not been discounted.
