

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COMPANIES HOUSE

The sheriff having resumed consideration of the foregoing petition together with the productions produced, and having seen the Edinburgh Gazette dated 28 JANUARY 2011 and the HERALD newspaper dated 29 JANUARY 2011 each containing the intimation ordered by the preceding interlocutor, no answers to said petition having been lodged in court, Finds (1) that the amount of the share capital of the said SMIDDY AGRI SERVICES LTD paid up or credited as paid up does not exceed £120,000 (2) that the said company is unable to pay its debts; therefore Orders that the said company having its registered office at Benston Smithy, Cumnock, KA18 4QA be wound up in pursuance of the Insolvency Act, 1986; Nominates and Appoints Derek Ewan Simpson, 69 Buchanan Street, Glasgow to be the interim liquidator of the said company with the usual powers, all in terms of said Statute and of Law; Finds the petitioner entitled to the expenses of this application as taxed by the auditor of court.
