- 1.2 The meeting agrees by special resolution of the members to convert the current articles of association so as to comply with requirements in connection with becoming a community interest company, and these new articles will be in substitution for, and to the exclusion of any articles of the company previously registered with the Registrar of Companies Proposed Anne Gracie Gunn, seconded Rob Ware agreed
- 1.3 The meeting agrees to change the name from SkyeConnect Ltd to SkyeConnect CIC Proposed Steve Smith, seconded Rob Ware agreed
- 1.4 The meeting agrees that the Community Interest Statement to be adopted by SkyeConnect should be / read
