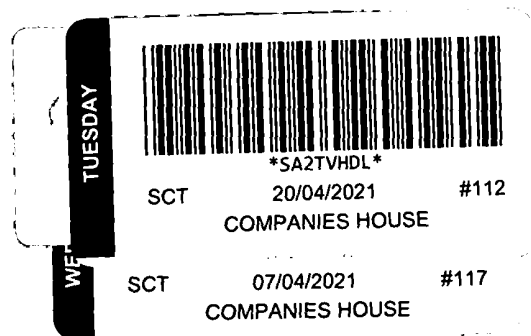

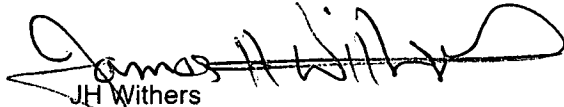

Due to Covid-19 our services have been severely disrupted and we have had to adapt where possible to continue this has included using digital practices and equipment to support people particularly in rural areas.

We have in partnership deliver online health & safety certificated courses to date to 20 support staff of individuals who control their own care budget and from organisations providing support. We have also created two community groups with 30 individuals using to combat social inclusion and loneliness using our Peace of Mind program..

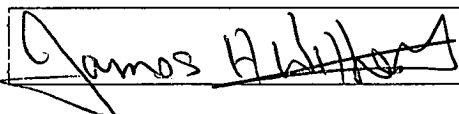
