1. Dispenses with intimation, service and advertisement of said Note/Petition;
2. Dispenses with a Remit to an independent Accountant on the Liquidator's intromissions;
3. Approves the Liquidator's whole actings and intromissions;
4. Exoner, Acquits and Discharges Stuart Robb, Insolvency Practitioner, Leonard Curtis Recovery Limited, 4th Floor, 58 Waterbo Street, Glasgow G2 7DA of their whole actings, intromissions and management as Liquidator of Pro-Build Contractors Limited;
5. Authorises the Liquidator to retain the balance of funds in his hands in the sum of **TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY EIGHT POUNDS AND TWENTY THREE PENCE (£2,878.23) STERLING** to account of his remuneration;
6. Orders that the said Pro-Build Contractors Limited (SC462800), c/o Leonard Curtis Recovery Limited, 4th Floor, 58 Waterbo Street, Glasgow G2 7DA be dissolved in terms of section 204(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986;
7. Ordains the Liquidator to intimate this order to the Registrar of Companies within 14 days from this date in terms of section 204(4) of the Insolvency act 1986, and to all creditors who have lodged claims; and
8. Dispenses with the need to convene a final meeting of creditors.
