



Variation	<p>A SHARES</p> <p>voting shares with equal rights on winding up</p> <p>Subject to the provisions of the Act, the Directors may declare an interim dividend and the Company may by ordinary resolution, upon the recommendation of the Directors, declare a final dividend but no dividend shall exceed the amount recommended by the Directors.</p> <p>Every meeting of the Directors, a committee of Directors or General Meeting of the Company at which a dividend is declared shall, by Board or Ordinary Resolution (as appropriate), direct that such dividend be paid either in respect of one or more class of shares to the exclusion of one or the other class, or in respect of all classes of shares.</p> <p>Where a dividend is declared in respect of one or all classes of shares the Company may, by ordinary resolution, differentiate between the classes as to the amount or percentage of dividend payable, but in default the shares in each such class shall be deemed to rank <i>pari passu</i> in all respects as if they constituted one class of share.</p>
