

(i) the Limited Liability Partnership will not, without the Bank's consent, permit or create any fixed security, floating charge or lien on any of its property, undertaking, assets (including any uncalled capital) or rights, whether ranking before or after the Floating Charge, except in favour of the Bank; (ii) any fixed charge given by the Limited Liability Partnership to the Bank will rank in priority to the Floating Charge; (iii) the Floating Charge will rank in priority to any fixed charge and any other floating charge granted by the Limited Liability Partnership after completion of the Floating Charge, unless the Bank agrees otherwise.

^① In the case of a floating charge a statement should be given of (1) the restrictions, if any, on the power of the LLP to grant further securities ranking in priority to, or pari passu with the floating charge; and / or (2) the provisions, if any, regulating the order in which the floating charge shall rank with any other subsisting or future floating charges or fixed securities over the property which is the subject of the floating charge or any part of it.
