NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented, unless otherwise stated.

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 1 to The Large and Medium-sized Companies and Groups (Accounts and Reports) Regulations 2008 ("SI2008/410") and applicable UK accounting standards

Under FRS 1 (Cash Flow Statements (revised 1996)), the Company is exempt from the requirement to prepare a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a subsidiary undertaking of a parent undertaking which produces a consolidated cash flow statement. The cash flow of the Company is consolidated in the Guardian Royal Exchange plc financial statements, which can be obtained from 5 Old Broad Street, London EC2N 1AD

The Company has applied all applicable accounting standards and interpretations effective at 31 December 2014. There have been no new standards, changes to standards and interpretations which are effective for accounting periods beginning on or after 1 January 2014 that have a material impact on these financial statements.
